Small Group Questions

- 1. Read through Ephesians 1:1-14. Yes! We have read this passage before! I am so glad you recognize it! Paul's heart is that the church, (the children) of God make sure they know these things deep down. As we know them intellectually and spiritually, our reality changes.
